

## Locating the Village

### Brethren Village

3001 Lititz Pike, Lancaster, PA 17606

Brethren Village is centrally located within Lancaster County, which offers an abundance of transit methods to visit our beautiful campus.



We are conveniently located ¼ mile from the Lancaster Airport (Code: LNS) with seamless connections to destinations throughout the United States. We are 3 miles from the Lancaster Amtrak Station (Code: LNC) servicing Philadelphia, Baltimore, Pittsburgh and Harrisburg daily.

When driving to the Village, please enter at our main entrance located on Rt. 501 at the intersection of Fieldcrest Drive and Bloomfield Drive. To visit our Residential Marketing Office, please continue past the Village to the intersection of Rt. 501 and Airport Road. Turn right on East Airport Road and proceed ¼ mile to 505 East Airport Road, adjacent to the Fairview Drive entrance to Brethren Village. Our Residential Marketing Office is located within 505 East Airport Road.

#### From Harrisburg and Points West:

Take PA Turnpike (Interstate 76) to Exit 247 (formerly Exit 19- Harrisburg East). Take Rt. 283 East to Rt. 30 East to Rt. 501 North. The Village is on the right side of Rt. 501 North, approximately three miles from US Route 30.

#### From Philadelphia and Points East:

Take PA Turnpike (Interstate 76) to Exit 286 (formerly Exit 21- Reading/Lancaster). Take Rt. 222 South to Rt. 30 West to Rt. 501 North.

#### From Allentown or Points North:

Take Rt. 222 South to Rt. 12 South. Take Rt. 422 West to Rt. 222 South. Continue on Rt. 222 South to Rt. 30 West to Rt. 501 North.

#### From Baltimore, MD or Points South:

Take Rt. 83 North to Rt. 30 East at York to Rt. 501 North.
