## Our process

Brethren Village Home Care aims to provide caring, compassionate and timely home care services to all our clients. In order to serve new clients better, we kindly ask for 48-hours notice before services can begin.

Our process includes an initial client assessment and a plan of care by one of our licensed Registered Nurses in the clients home. The establishment of a care plan involves the client's doctors, specialists and family members. Our team of licensed Home Care Team Members range from Homemakers to Licensed Practical Nurses with oversight from a Registered Nurse, who serves as the client's case manager. All Team Members undergo an interview process and an extensive criminal background check. Additionally, Team Members are fully insured and bonded by Brethren Village.

- Assistance with Mechanical Lifts

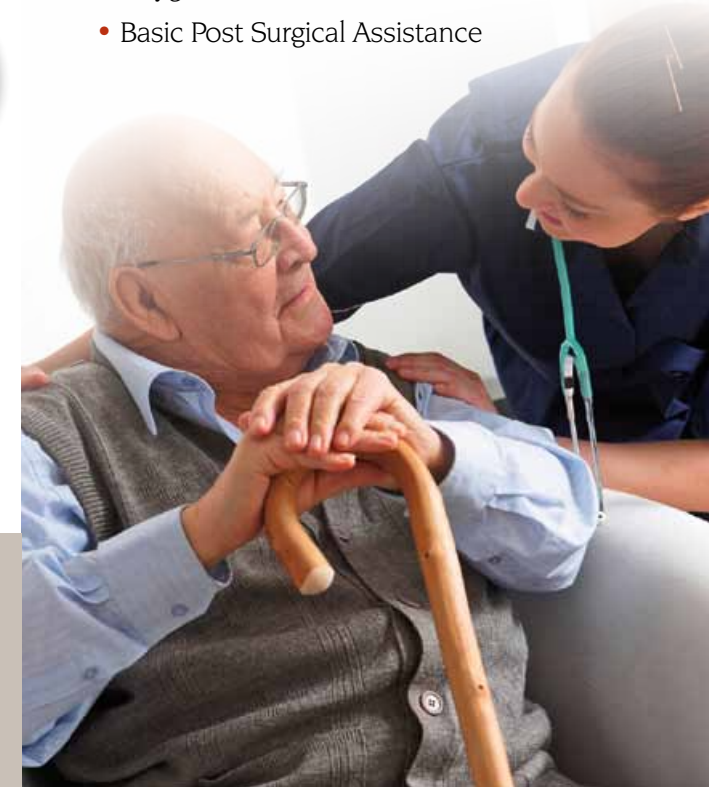


### Our nursing services
