From the President

elcome to the 2007 Annual Report Issue of the Villager! This edition will highlight successes

of the past year, current events on the Village campus, and plans for the future of our ministry.

This past year has most certainly been unlike any other in the Village's 110-year history. It has been unlike some 30 years ago when the Village was planning an expansion of 93-healthcare center beds, 39 Oakwood House apartments, and 59 Village Manor assisted living rooms. It has been unlike 15 years ago when the Village was planning 137 Fieldcrest apartments.

During the past year we witnessed the completion of construction and occupancy of 60 one-bedroom apartments, Fairview Meadows, specifically designed as affordable housing for seniors. We also witnessed the completion of construction and occupancy of the most recently "sold out" Meadowcrest Cottages. These latest facilities provide a living room, dining area, large kitchen, sunroom, two-bedrooms, two and a half baths, and a two-car garage. However, it does not stop there!

Later this year, the Village is nearing commencement of construction for our largest redevelopment and expansion to date—a new 120-bed healthcare center, 36-beds of assisted living, 25-beds of assisted living memory support, 137-additional Fieldcrest apartments, and a new Welcome Center.

What do we attribute this growth and success of the Village's ministry? First, and above all else, "God is good and has blessed His ministry at Brethren Village." As I meet with many new residents as they move to the independent living portion of our campus, I hear similar stories. These are stories of the process by which residents went through as they selected Brethren Village as their "retirement community of choice." These are stories of residents who were previously served in the Village's healthcare center and have now moved to an apartment or cottage. Or who knew of someone who was served well in the healthcare center or lived in the independent living portion of our campus. In short, these are 'repeat customers' or those who learned of the Village through 'word-of-mouth.' These are stories of residents who conducted an exhaustive process of considering their options and ultimately selected Brethren Village because of the Village's programs, services and alignment of personal values to the Village's values.

Just a few weeks ago, I had the opportunity of meeting retired Senator John Glenn, and twice astronaut. When asked what motivated him to return to space at age 77— he is now age 86— he referred to the research value of learning of the effects of extended weightlessness on someone of his age and his various research projects and responsibilities aboard the spacecraft. Now while orbiting the globe at over 4-miles per second and witnessing a new sunrise and sunset approximately every 90-minutes, Senator Glenn does not represent a typical new resident. However, I have seen the fundamental characteristics displayed by Senator Glenn represented in many of the Village's residents— a quest for continued learning, an appreciation for the beauty of God's creation, a recognition of the importance of maintaining physical fitness and a sincere desire to give back a fair portion of those gifts with which we are blessed. Yes, the Village residents are an inspiration to many of us and the Village provides opportunity for the lives of many residents to be enhanced.

Undoubtedly, the Village's success, both past and future, is a result of many individuals including a supportive and vision-focused Board of Directors, a professional and dedicated leadership and management team, more than 400 team members who provide outstanding customer service, more than 850 residents who make this campus a true "village," hundreds of volunteers who give of themselves unselfishly, the Village Auxiliary who provide both valued services and generous financial support and many others who support the Village through prayers and finances.

As we focus on the Village's vision and filter our ministry through our core values of 'caring, integrity, stewardship and excellence,' we celebrate the past year's successes and anticipate the future of the Village.

Financial Information

reetings! Over 110-years ago, a group of elders within the Church of the Brethren had a vision, a dream whereby those in need— the poor, the infirmed and the aged— would be cared for in the servant style of Jesus. This dream became a reality when in February 1897, seven inmates moved into The German Baptist Brethren Home. Much has changed from those early days but one thing has remained constant: our commitment to serve others in their time of need by following the servant style of Jesus. Now serving more than 850 residents and their families, employing more than 400 team members and still modeling the

servant style of Jesus, Brethren Village has evolved into a leading continuing care retirement communities in the Lancaster area.

Our core values of caring, integrity, stewardship and excellence provide the framework within which our vision and mission statements are fulfilled. Please know that all four values are essential for the organization's success; however, integrity and stewardship are paramount in terms of financial information and results.

Regarding integrity, our auditors as in past years, have issued an unqualified or 'clean' opinion on our financial statements which represents the highest level of assurance provided by an independent auditor. Additionally, our auditors identified no adjustments to our financial records. Included with this report are three charts which highlight the financial results of the past three fiscal years and illustrate the organization's continued growth and demonstrate our stewardship of the resources entrusted to us by Him.

The following condensed financial information represents the consolidated statements of operations and balance sheets for Brethren Village and Affiliates for the years ended June 30, 2007 and 2006 as taken from the audited financial statements.

Condensed Statement of Operations

Our total net revenues increased approximately \$1,816,000— or 7.33 percent, from 2006 to 2007. Revenues are comprised of resident service revenue, meaning services and/or items billed to residents; other operating revenue; contributions; investment income; and net assets released from restriction.

Resident service revenue increased by \$1,827,000 over the prior years due to higher occupancy in our healthcare center and assisted living; increases in the reimbursement rates from Medicare and Medicaid; and improved payor mix. Other operating revenue increased \$121,000 from the prior year while contributions remained fairly constant, increasing by \$7,000 over the prior year. Investment income decreased by \$265,000 from 2006 to 2007. This decrease was directly related to realized gains from 2006 which were not repeated in 2007. Net assets released from restriction represented the transfer of earnings from our endowment to subsidize benevolent care. The increase from the prior year is intentional and correlates to management's plans for redevelopment of campus.

Our total expenses increased approximately \$1,088,000— or 4.54 percent, from 2006 to 2007. Expenses are comprised of salaries; benefits; other; depreciation and amortization; interest; and expenses of Brethren Services, Inc. and Brethren Services II, Inc. (Affiliates).

Salaries increased by \$231,000 while benefits decreased by \$250,000 over the prior year. The increases in salaries correlated to wage increases for team members. The decreased costs for benefits corresponds to implementation and recognition of the underfunded status of our pension plan. This recognition stems from a new accounting standard and requires disclosure as a separate financial line item below the operating income line. Approximately \$471,000 was recognized below the line. Other expenses increased by \$1,034,000 over the prior year— primary element is approximately \$566,000 of loss on disposal of fixed assets. As part of our campus redevelopment, several existing buildings have been taken out of service and eventually will be taken down. Our 2007 financials

include recognition of the loss on these fixed assets. Depreciation and amortization remained relatively flat with an increase of about \$47,000. Interest expense decreased by \$56,000 from 2006 to 2007 as the result of debt repayment. Expenses of Affiliates increased \$83,000 from 2006 to 2007 as a result of opening our second affordable housing building, Fairview Meadows.

Our operating income improved by \$728,000 from \$809,000 in 2006 to \$1,537,000 in 2007. Additionally, 2007 results included several other items 'below the line' which significantly affected the total increase in net assets. These items are receipt of \$4,852,000 in government grants used to purchase property and equipment; a swing in unrealized gains of about \$606,000 from an unrealized loss of \$264,000 in 2006 to an unrealized gain of \$342,000 in 2007; and the recognition of the unfunded status of our defined benefit pension plan – about \$471,000.

Condensed Balance Sheet

Current assets demonstrated a solid cash position as of June 30, 2007 with 129 days cash on hand and 27 days in accounts receivable. Our investments reflected growth over the prior year as the result of reinvestment of realized gains and contributions to restricted funds. Property and equipment increased by \$10,861,000, considering the net impact of capital additions, including Meadowcrest Cottages and Fairview Meadows, depreciation and disposals. Other assets increased by \$1,060,000, primarily because of the marketing costs of acquiring initial contracts through our redevelopment efforts (about \$911,000).

Current liabilities increased by \$83,000 as the result of variation within the payroll accrual. Increase in annuities and other liabilities of \$624,000 stemmed from recognition of the unfunded status of our defined benefit pension plan. The net increase of \$2,353,000 in long term debt represents repayment of debt of approximately \$1,054,000 and the issuance of new debt of approximately \$3,407,000. The majority of the new debt— about \$2,601,000— related to our campus redevelopment project and is expected to be repaid in full at time of permanent financing. Increase in unearned entrance fees of \$2,783,000 represented the net effect of the following: new entrance fees of \$5,842,000 – higher than usual because opening of Meadowcrest Cottages, refunds of \$676,000 and amortization of \$2,383,000.


Net assets increased by \$6,864,000 with unrestricted net assets increasing by \$6,263,000, temporarily restricted net assets increasing by \$364,000, and permanently restricted net assets increasing by \$237,000.




