This past year, Brethren Village has provided <u>\$2,395,000</u> in assistance to <u>82</u> Residents in Village Manor, Memory Support and The Courtyards, through the Good Samaritan Fund.

In **The Courtyards**, we offset costs for Residents who are receiving medical assistance. We do receive compensation from the state, but the compensation falls profoundly short of the actual cost for Brethren Village to provide care to these Residents.
