Here's What is Changing

Residential Living Visitors:

- Visitation is open to 4 visitors at a time.
- All visitors will be screened prior to entering.
- Visitors are restricted to Resident cottage/ apartment or outside.
- Visitors are welcome from 5 AM — 10 PM daily.

Activities:

- Temperature screening required.
- Support groups resume with 10 people or less.
- Small group activities of 10 people or less.
- Presenters will be live on BVTV Channel 4.
- Bands will be live on BVTV Channel 4.
- Outside small gatherings for music entertainment will take place around campus.

Wellness:

- Temperature screening required.
- Limited outdoor class size with chairs social distanced.
- Digital fitness classes will remain on BVTV.
- Zoom yoga and fitness classes will begin.

Please continue to wear a cloth facemask in all public indoor areas and outdoors when others are around; maintain proper social distance of at least 6 feet; wash your hands often.

Here's What is Still in Place

- Maintain single-point of entry/exit, screening.
- Residential buildings will remain locked.
- Residents and visitors must wear a face mask when outside of their residence.
- Social distancing in all areas continues.
- Groups of more than 10 are prohibited.
- Continue frequent hand hygiene.
- **Dining** venues remain open for take-out, delivery and specialty pop-up events only.
- **Chapel** services remain digital.

Visitors:

- Visitation to Supportive Living remains restricted.
- No overnight guests in Residential Living.
- No visitors gathering in common areas.

Activities:

- Maintain social distance.
- No large gatherings/events.
- No out-of-state travel.

Wellness:

- Maintain social distance.
- Masks must be worn to outdoor class.
- Fitness Center and Pool will remain closed.
- TC Fitness Room remains available for Team Member use.

Stay tuned for communication on the reopening of the Gift Shop, Thrift Shop, Train Room, Work Shop & the Creative Arts Room. At this time, they remain closed.
